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The *Writing Center Journal's* primary purpose is to publish articles, reviews, and announcements of interest to writing center personnel. We therefore invite manuscripts that explore issues or theories related to writing center dynamics or administration. We are especially interested in theoretical articles and in reports of research related to or conducted in writing centers. In addition to college and university writing center workers, we encourage high school writing center workers to submit manuscripts.

### Guidelines for Submission

1. Manuscripts should be between 4,000 and 8,000 words and should include a list of works cited. Manuscripts should follow the *NCTE Guidelines for Non-sexist Use of Language* and the *MLA Handbook*, 5th edition.
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  - b. As a non-Word attachment or enclosure to an e-mail message. Follow the instructions above, but save the document as an ASCII or text-only file (with no line breaks).
  - c. As a MS Word file on computer disk, labeled with the name of the author, the file, and the version of MS Word used.
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
