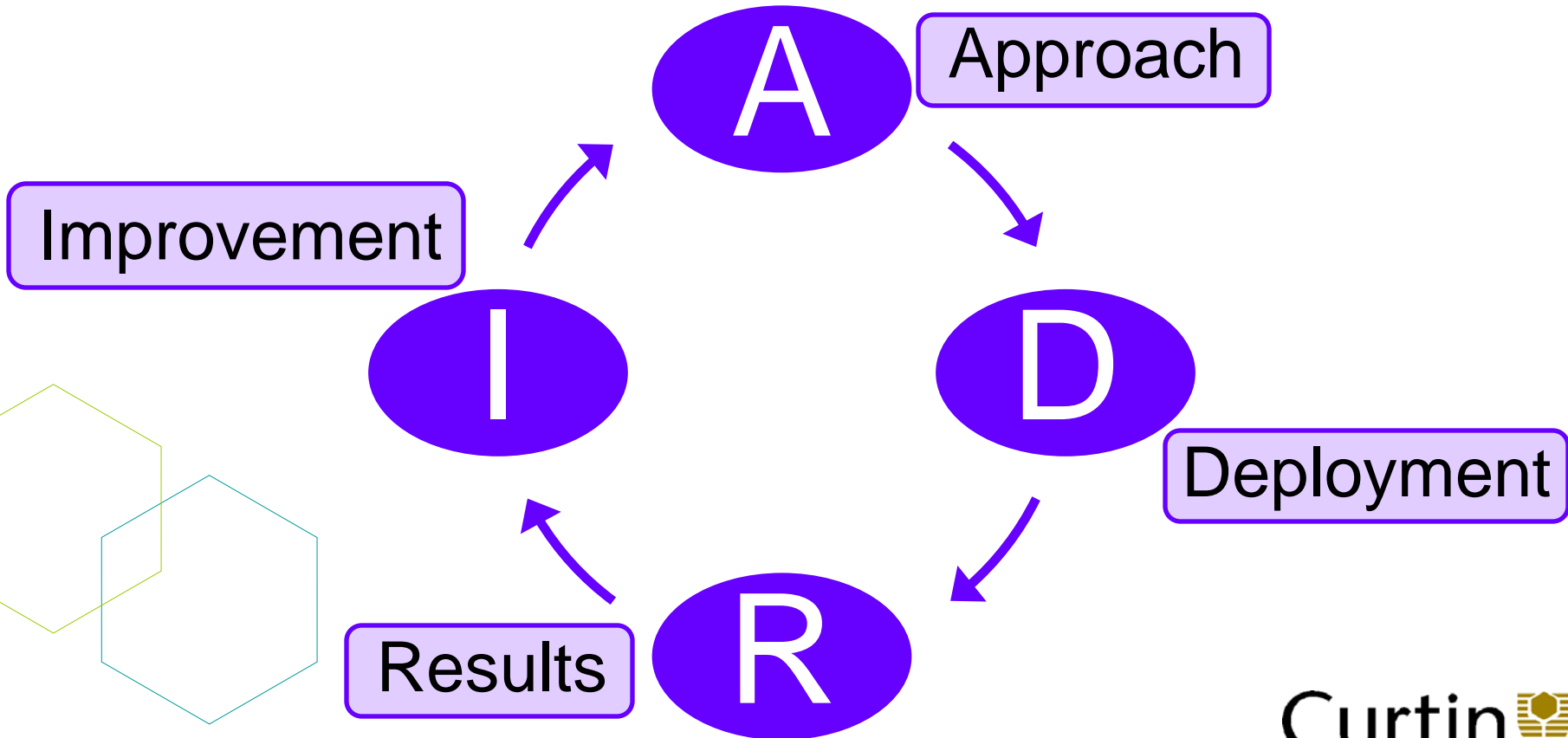

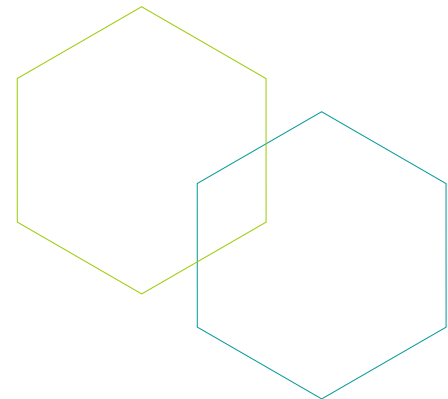




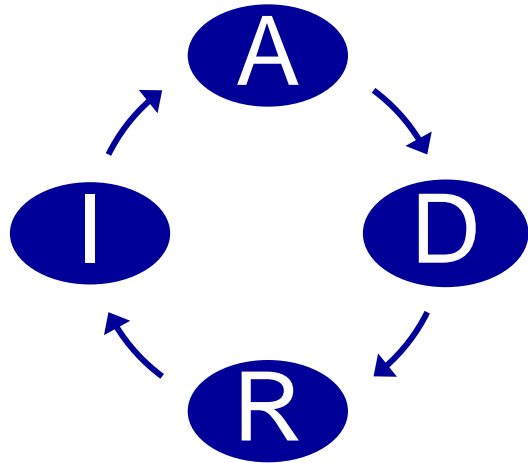

Planning Framework

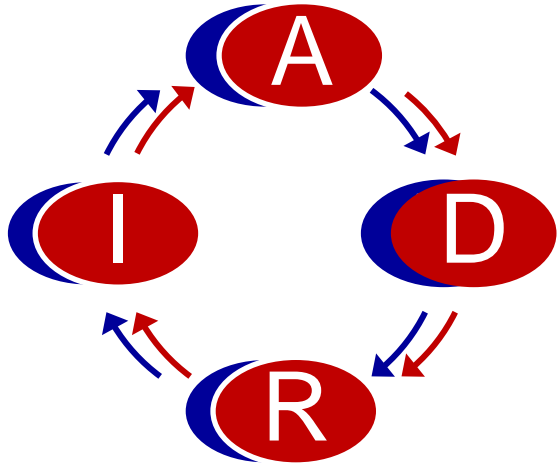
A 5-year and Annual Plans developed

R Quarterly reviews and reports

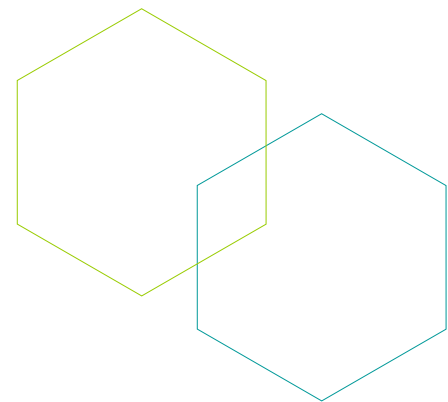
I Corrective action taken; ideas for future initiatives identified
